Newington Armory Group Tour

Reflect upon the past as you explore Newington Armory. Listen to stories of depot working life during its years operating as a Naval Armament Depot. Take time to view displays of armament and other equipment. Tour includes small amount of walking.

The tour highlights:

- Dedicated Tour Guide for every 20 participants.
- Tour commentary aboard the heritage train.
- Guided exploration of the original 1897 precinct and wharf.
- A torch lit walk through the lantern passageways of the original gunpowder magazine (not open to the public).
- Access to former explosives storehouse and laboratory.
- Interpretive working life display and armament display.
- Exclusive access to Newington Armory and the Heritage Train.

Tour Duration: 2 hours (Monday to Friday)

Tour Cost: For up to 40 participants \$640

How to find Newington Armory

By road, Newington Armory is accessed via Jamieson Street (off Holker Street), Sydney Olympic Park.

- Free car parking is available at Blaxland Riverside Park.
- Bus and coach passenger set down and pick up is available at the turning circle of the main Blaxland Riverside Park Car Park. Bus and coach parking is located a short distance away in Jamieson Street.

By ferry from Sydney Olympic Park Ferry Wharf it is a 1,550m level walk along the River to Newington Armory.
